Pupils in Second Class will celebrate this Sacrament on Saturday May 27th in the Church of the Ascension Balally. The ceremony will begin at 11.am.

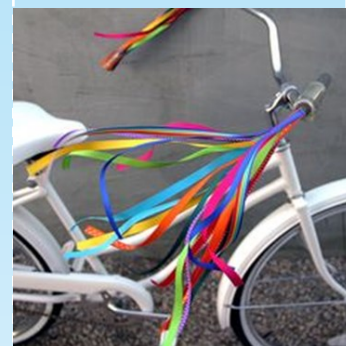
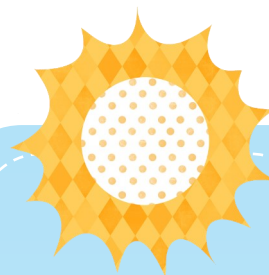
International Children's Day
