A final order will be placed tomorrow Wednesday for outstanding book orders. Please contact the school office now if you have fees outstanding.

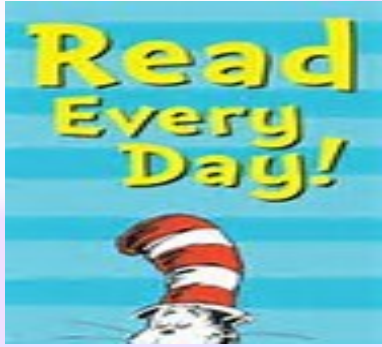
Medical Needs

Child Protection

Dear Parents,

The Department of Education & Skills has published *Child Protection Procedures for Primary and Post Primary Schools*. Ensuring the protection and welfare of children is the responsibility of all of us who work with children and young people. Child protection must be a priority for every school and must be at the core of all of our activities. There is an obligation on schools to provide children with the highest possible standard of care in order to promote their well being and protect them from harm.

Because of the close contact school staff members have with children they are well placed to observe changes in children's behaviour, their lack of development or outward signs of abuse. In situations where any member of a school staff suspects that a child may be at risk of neglect or abuse, they must make sure that this is reported to the to the HSE and An Garda Síochána.

This reporting is done by the **Designated Liaison Person [DLP]**.

Every school must have a senior member of staff who fills this role.
