We will be having a sponsored disco instead of a sponsored walk this year! On Thursday 18th May, the whole school will boogie the day away to raise money for school resources.

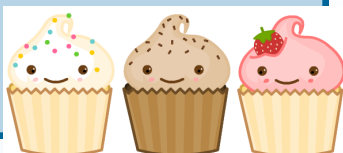
We really need all families to support this in any way they can. This is one of our main fundraising events this year, and is particularly important as we are one of the only schools in the area to have no voluntary contribution.
