Covid -19 Return to School Reminders

I want to thank all parents, guardians and pupils who have helped to make our return to school safe and a positive experience for us all.

We ask again that you do not drive past the Glenbourne/ Glencairn junction if you are coming to school by car. Many parents are helping by parking in the Dunnes Stores car-park and walking the short two minute journey to the school gate. The additional space allows parents and pupils exercise social distancing when at or around the school entrance. Please do not park in front of driveways. Our local residents must be allowed to enter and exit their homes safely and without hindrance.

Please do not assemble at the school entrance and allow as much space for the assembly period for all pupils to safely approach and enter the school grounds.

There is a growing issue with crowding in the school yard in the morning. Only pupils starting school at 8.40 a.m. should enter the school yard before 8.40a.m. If siblings start at different times, the entire family come to the yard for the later start.

A reminder that parents of 1^{st} and 2^{nd} class pupils should only enter the school when your child's class has lined up for collection. Again, crowding in the yard at this time is a concern.

All parents should wear masks at drop-off and pick-up times. Thank you for your cooperation.
