

School Update
27th August 2020

Morning time

- Thank you for your co-operation this morning and this afternoon.
- A 'car-free zone' significantly helps to operate a safe entry to school.
- Now that you have seen how our system operates, we encourage you to leave your child near the gate where they can walk in safely and independently.
- Parents must not congregate at the gate or anywhere around the school fencing in the morning. This is to ensure all our safety, and safe pedestrian access for all our community.
- Please leave the vicinity promptly.
- Social distancing must be adhered. The recommendation is that masks should be worn by adults for arrival and dismissal.

Junior Infant Collection

The Junior Infant collection ran very smoothly. Again please note finish times tomorrow:

- Ms Mannion class finish at 11.50a.m.
- Ms. Culligan's Class finish at 12. noon.
- Ms Walsh's finish at 12.10 p.m.

- These finish times will continue until Friday September 4th.

Senior Infant Collection

- To allow a staggered pick up for Senior Infant pupils, this is our plan going forward
- Ms. Lynn/ Hallissey's class Collection Time: 1.10p.m. (Parents will wait in the cobbled area in front of the school before picking up their child.)
- Ms. Morrissey's class Collection Time: 1.15p.m. Ms. Morrissey's parents should queue along the fence outside the school on Levmoos Avenue before being called into the yard.
- Ms. Callanan's Class Collection Time: 1.20p.m. Ms . Callanan's class parents will queue along the railing outside the school between the main gate and the staff car-park. You will be called into the yard when is safe to pick up your child.

First Class Collection 2.30p.m

Pupils will be handed over directly and in person to siblings, parents or guardians. For this reason, parents of First Class pupils are allowed into the school yard.

Order of Class Dismissal:

- **1. Ms O Connor's Class** Parents will assemble in the cobbled area at the front of the school. Parents will queue to collect their child and leave the school grounds as quickly as possible.
- **2. Mr Terry's Class** Parents should queue at the railing along Levmoos Avenue. Parents will be allowed into the collection point to collect their child and leave promptly when it is safe to do so..
- **3. Ms Ryan's Class** Parents should queue along the railing between main gate and staff car-park. Ms. Ryan's class parents will be invited into the yard and collect their child as soon as it is safe to do so.
- This will be an efficient and much safer way to ensure pupils are dismissed safely.

Second Class Collection 2.20p.m.

Pupils will be handed over directly and in person to siblings, parents or guardians. For this reason, parents of Second Class pupils are allowed into the school yard.

Order of Class Dismissal:


- **1. Ms Cahill's Class** Parents will assemble in the cobbled area at the front of the school. Parents will queue to collect their child and leave the school grounds as quickly as possible.
- **2. Ms. O Dwyer's Class** Parents should queue at the railing along Levmoos Avenue. Parents will be allowed into the collection point to collect their child and leave promptly when it is safe to do so..
- **3. Ms. Asple's Class** Parents should queue along the railing between main gate and staff car-park. Ms. Ryan's class parents will be invited into the yard and collect their child as soon as it is safe to do so.
- This will be an efficient and much safer way to ensure pupils are dismissed safely.

Third Collection 2.30pm & Fourth Class Collection 2.20p.m.

- **Parents should wait outside the fence on Levmoos Avenue at the 'smiley face' in the diagram on the next page.**
- **3rd and 4th Class lines have been moved nearer the roadway (in the basketball courts beside Levmoos Avenue) so that teachers can identify and recognise parents outside the fence and dispatch pupils when they see and get the attention of the waiting parent.**
- **When called by the teacher, pupils will move towards the main gate and towards their waiting parents.**


Simple map of where 3rd and 4th class

- Pupils will be brought to a point in the basketball courts where they and their teacher can see their parents/ guardians for pick-up. Parents should be outside the fence at the 'smiley face'.



5th & 6th Class Dismissal

- The 5th and 6th class pick-up ran smoothly. Pupils who are waiting for siblings will be brought to a secure area while they wait for a sibling at later pick-up. 5th and 6th Class parents are not allowed come into the yard.
